30. Crocodiles Lair Chardonnay – South Africa 2009 £33.95
Superb wine greatly influenced by a maritime climate providing a real depth of flavour
31. Chablis, Premier les cru Les Vaillons – France 2008 £49.50
The Chanel of French white wine, creamy texture with a bone dry finish
32. Sans Barrique – Bouchard Finlayson - South Africa 2009 £31.50
Un-oaked chardonnay similar in character to Chablis. A classic in the making
